Traineeships

A pathway to employment and a way to 'give back'- £1,000 incentives for each work placement trainee (up to ten trainees per employer)

Traineeships provide young people aged 16-24 with industry specific training and work experience of between 70 – 100 hours duration and can last between six weeks and six months. The government's £111m investment means:

- Employers taking on a trainee from 1 September 2020 will receive a £1,000 Government grant (up to ten trainees per employer).
- Eligibility has expanded to anyone aged 16-24 with qualifications up to Level 3 (equivalent to 'A' Level).
